SmoothBeam Laser treatment

SmoothBeam Laser treatment can clear acne and keep it from returning with just four monthly treatments! Occasionally one or two more treatments may be needed for optimal results in some patients.

Scientific studies showed up to 98 percent clearing of acne lesions after four treatments, done once per month. As of two years following the study, most of these patients had remained free of significant acne. In our practice, using the SmoothBeam Laser for the last six years to treat acne, we have seen over 80 percent of our patients treated with four or more treatments remain clear or almost clear of acne lesions for years following their treatments. A small percentage of patients need to be re-treated after several years. These are usually young patients who develop severe acne in their early teens.

★ **HOW IT WORKS**

SmoothBeam diode laser

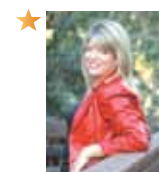
SmoothBeam is a diode laser that targets the sebaceous (oil) glands in the upper part of the dermal layer of the skin. These glands are the source of bacterial growth, oiliness, and inflammation in the skin. These factors combine to produce pimples, pustules, blackheads, and cysts. By permanently shrinking these glands, acne can be cured. This laser treatment can replace years of antibiotic treatment or isotretinoin (Accutane) treatment for many patients. SmoothBeam also stimulates collagen production, improving many acne scars. After treatment, patients look and feel normal

(except for one to two days of mild redness) and can return to work or school immediately. There is no down time.

In our practice we have found the SmoothBeam Laser to be as effective as Accutane treatment and more effective than oral and topical antibiotics. It is also more effective than Blue Light and other light based treatments which only temporarily clear acne but do not permanently shrink the sebaceous glands.

SmoothBeam Laser is very safe. Risks are extremely rare (less than 1%) and include temporary darkening of skin. Reactions include discomfort during treatment and redness (usually lasting less than 1-2 days after each treatment.) It is important to avoid sun-tanning for six weeks after treatment and to use sunscreens daily. For comfort, we recommend applying a topical anesthetic ointment one hour before each SmoothBeam Laser treatment.

Suffering with acne, going on Accutane or being on antibiotics for years are no longer the only options. Thanks to modern technology, SmoothBeam Laser is available.
